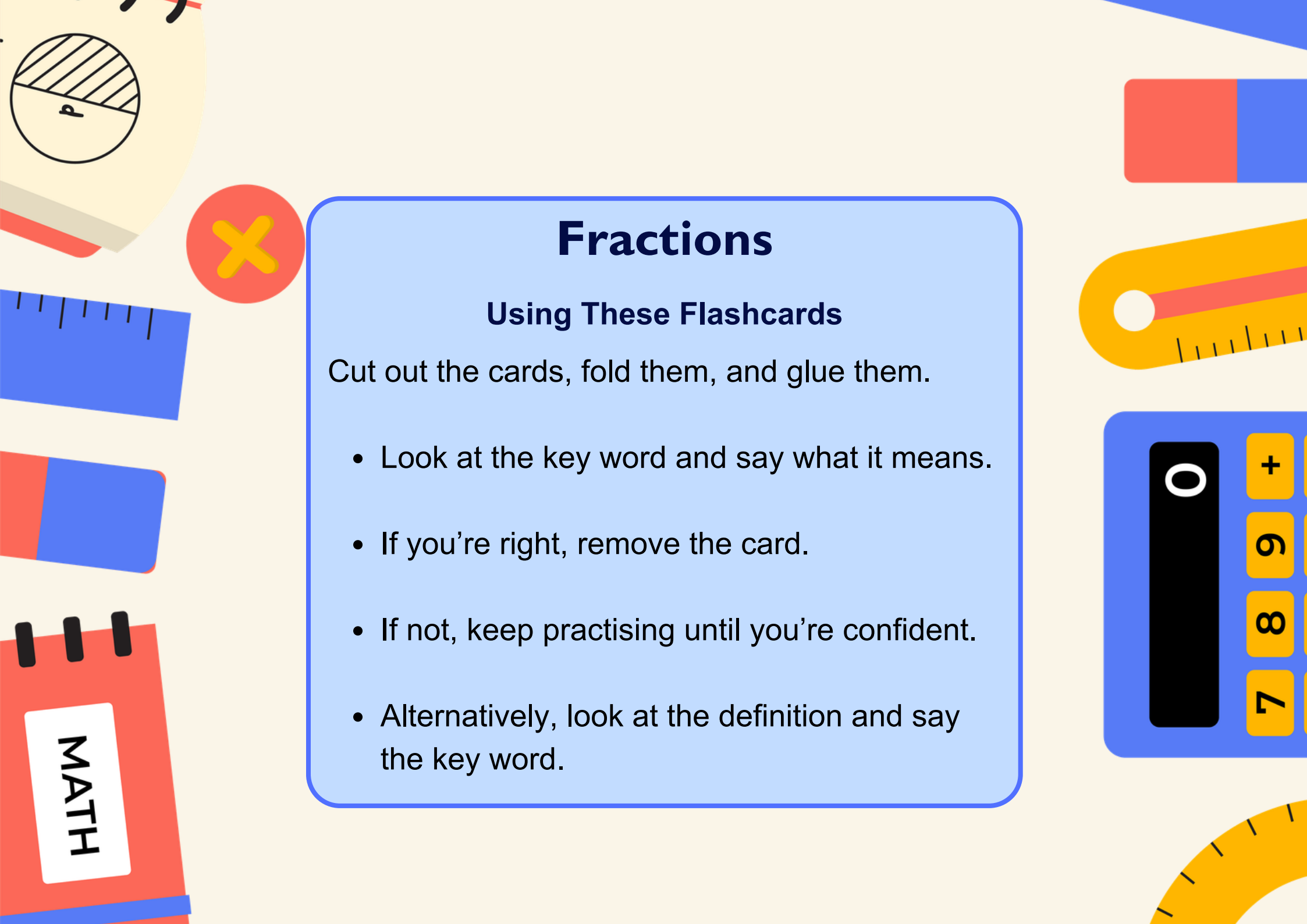




Fractions

Using These Flashcards

Whole



A **whole** is one complete thing.

Example: One full chocolate bar.

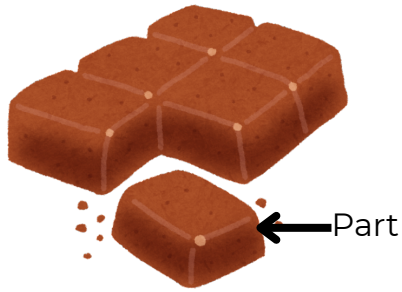
Equal



Equal means the parts are the same size.

Example: 12 equal pieces.

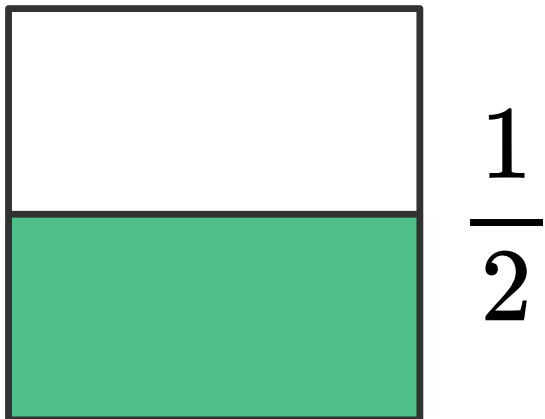
Part



A **part** is one of the equal pieces.

Example: One square from a chocolate bar with 12 squares.

Fraction



A **fraction** shows how many parts of a whole we have.

Example: $\frac{1}{2}$ = one part out of two.

Numerator



The **numerator** is the top number in a fraction. It tells you how many parts we have.

Example: In $\frac{1}{4}$, the numerator is 1.

Denominator



The **denominator** is the bottom number in a fraction. It tells you how many equal parts the whole has been split into.

Example: In $\frac{1}{4}$, the denominator is 4.

Equivalent fractions have the same value even though they look different.

Example: $\frac{1}{2} = \frac{2}{4} = \frac{3}{6} = \frac{4}{8}$

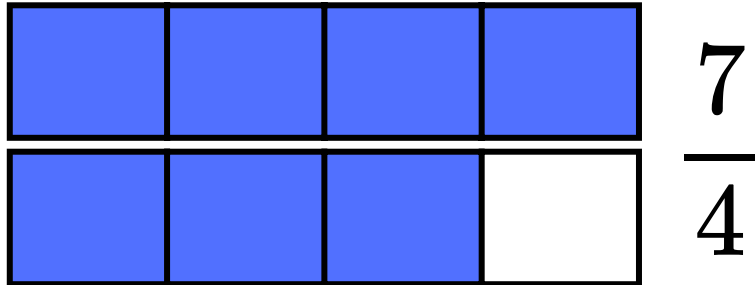
Unit Fraction



A **unit fraction** has a top number of 1.

Example: $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$

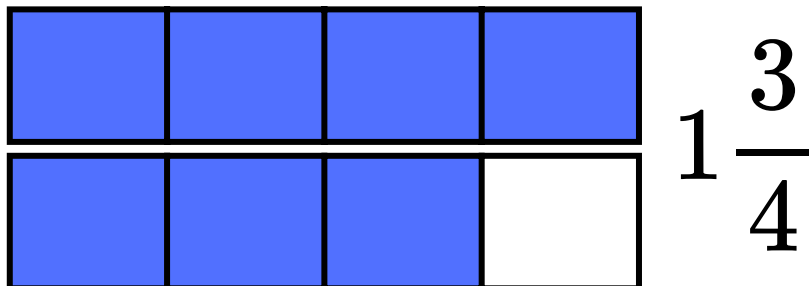
Improper Fraction



An **improper fraction** has a top number that is greater than or equal to the bottom number.

Example: $\frac{7}{4}$

Mixed Number



A **mixed number** has a whole number and a fraction.

Example: $1\frac{3}{4}$
